

ROBOTIC PROGRAMMING WORKSHOP

On 11th and 12th October 2019, Pejabat Dewan Undangan Negeri DUN Kemelah has taken an initiative to organize a robotic programming workshop in collaboration with Pejabat Pendidikan Daerah (PPD) Segamat and Faculty of Engineering, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) which was held in ICT Hall, Tunku Abdul Rahman University College (TAR UC), Segamat. This workshop involved 110 students and 32 teachers from 21 schools in surrounding area of Segamat especially in Dun Kemelah.

In line with the 4th Industrial Revolution (4IR) in achieving technological development, this workshop aims to expose and foster computer programming interest through robotic programming skills among students.

Pejabat Dewan Undangan Negeri DUN Kemelah has donated 15 sets of robots to 5 secondary schools in Dun Kemelah. Each school received 3 sets of robots for the use of robotic programming exercises. This initiative helped in introducing students to programming through robotic. The robot was developed in collaboration with School of Electrical Engineering and School of Computing, Faculty of Engineering, UTM. Since 2012, this robot has been given an official name which is RoboKar, in adaptation and use in learning system and introduction to computer programming through robotics to different education levels, which is school and university levels. The presentation of the RoboKar sets to the schools was officiated by YB Dr. Sulaiman Mohd Nor at the ICT Hall, TAR UC.
