In order to actively engage in identifying civic issues, one must :


Have the ability to question culture and how this understanding is represented in communities

Reflect of one own culture is important, so he can reflect on aspects of other cultures

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

- 1. Africa: Development of democratic institution and peace of warring nation
- 2. Ageing: Growth in number of older persons in population
- 3. AIDS: Averted 30 million new HIV infections and nearly 8 million deaths
- 4. Atomic Energy: More than 30 countries are operating 444 nuclear reactors
- 5. Big Data for the SDGs: The volume of data in the world is increasing exponentially
- **6. Children**: Millions of children are denied a fair chance for no reason
- 7. Climate Change: Shifting weather patterns and rising sea levels
- 8. Decolonization: Wave of decolonization changed the face of the planet
- **9. Democracy**: Provides an environment for protection of human rights
- 10.Ending Poverty: One in ten people still lives on less than \$1.90 a day
- 11.Food: One in nine people do not get enough food
