Competition rules

- Only <u>ONE single</u> static PowerPoint slide is permitted. No slide transitions, animations or 'movement' of any description are allowed. The slide is to be presented from the beginning of the oration.
- · No additional electronic media (e.g. sound and video files) are permitted.
- · No additional props (e.g. costumes, musical instruments, laboratory equipment) are permitted.
- Presentations are limited to <u>3 minutes maximum</u> and competitors exceeding 3minutes are disqualified.
- · Presentations are to be spoken word (e.g. no poems, raps or songs).
- · Presentations are to commence from the stage.
- Presentations are considered to have commenced when a presenter starts their presentation through either movement or speech.
- The decision of the adjudicating panel is final.
