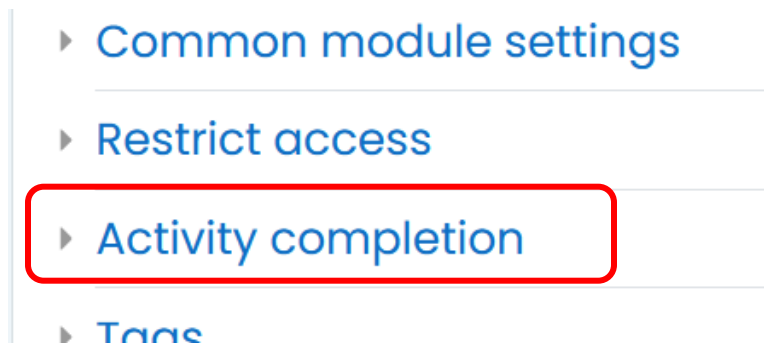


## How to set restriction in e-learning.

Suppose we want a certain activity (let us call it ACT1) to be completed by students before they can start on a new one (ACT2). How do we set this?

### Step 1

- We start with ACT1.
- On this activity, go to *Edit Settings* – then *Activity Completion*.



- Under Activity Completion, you will see the following

#### ▼ Activity completion

Completion tracking ⓘ

Require view ☐ Student must view this activity to complete it

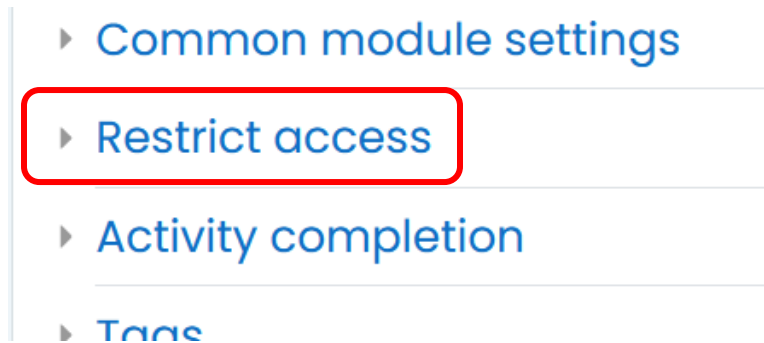
☒ View as completed if the feedback is submitted

Expect completed on ⓘ      ⓘ ☐ Enable

- Set the **Completion Tracking** to *Show activity complete when conditions are met*.
- In addition, in the **Require** view click on *View as completed if the feedback is submitted*. \*Note: In this case, ACT1 is a Feedback activity.
- Expect completion can be set if you want it completed on a certain time and date.
- Done, we move on to ACT2.

## Step 2

- Now that we have prepped ACT1, we manage the settings in ACT2.
- On this activity, go to *Edit Settings* – then *Restrict Access*.



- Under *Restrict Access*, you will see the following.

### ▼ Restrict access

- Click on *Add Restriction*. You will see many options available.

#### Add restriction...

Activity completion	Require students to complete (or not complete) another activity.
Date	Prevent access until (or from) a specified date and time.
Grade	Require students to achieve a specified grade.
User profile	Control access based on fields within the student's profile.
Restriction set	Add a set of nested restrictions to apply complex logic.
Cancel	

- In this example, we will choose *Activity completion*. Now you need to choose which activity **MUST** complete before this particular activity is activated.
  - In our example here: Click on **Choose** and it will list all activities that have the Activity Completion set.
  - Choose ACT1 from the list.
  - Done.

- You can of course add more than one restrictions, depending on your need. However, for the purpose of this simple tutorial, you are done.
- On the main area now, under ACT2 there will be a message shown as below.

**Restricted** Not available unless: The activity [ACT1](#) is marked complete
