

1.11 Table of Contents Page

The Table of Contents page must start on a new page. It should list all sections, chapters and sub-headings. The titles must be written using the same words as those written in the text. See example in Appendix K.

1.12 List of Tables

This page should list all the tables found in the thesis. The page number of the table must also be included. The table numbers should be arranged according to the chapters. See example in Appendix L.

1.13 List of Figures

Diagrams, photographs, drawings, graphs, charts and maps are included as figures. The list should be written similar as the List of Tables. See example in Appendix M.

1.14 List of Symbols/Abbreviations/Notations/Terminology

All symbols or abbreviations or notations or terminology found in the text should be listed on this page. They are listed in the following order:

- Roman letters - alphabetical order
- Greek letters - alphabetical order
- Superscripts - alphabetical order
- Subscripts - alphabetical order

1.15 List of Appendices

All appendices should be listed on this page. See example in Appendix o.
