

Ledge paths

Ledge paths provide attractive landscape experiences as they afford users prospect (views over surrounding landscape) on one side while providing enclosure on the other. A ledge path may be as simple as a single step up from the space it surrounds, or as dramatic as a cliff-hugging route. Ledge paths are often desirable or

necessary next to seas, rivers, lakes and canals, enabling walks with prospect of water or fishing (See also the section on Water paths, p. 112). Pavements with kerbs are ledge paths that protect users from vehicles. Ledge paths can enclose spaces.
