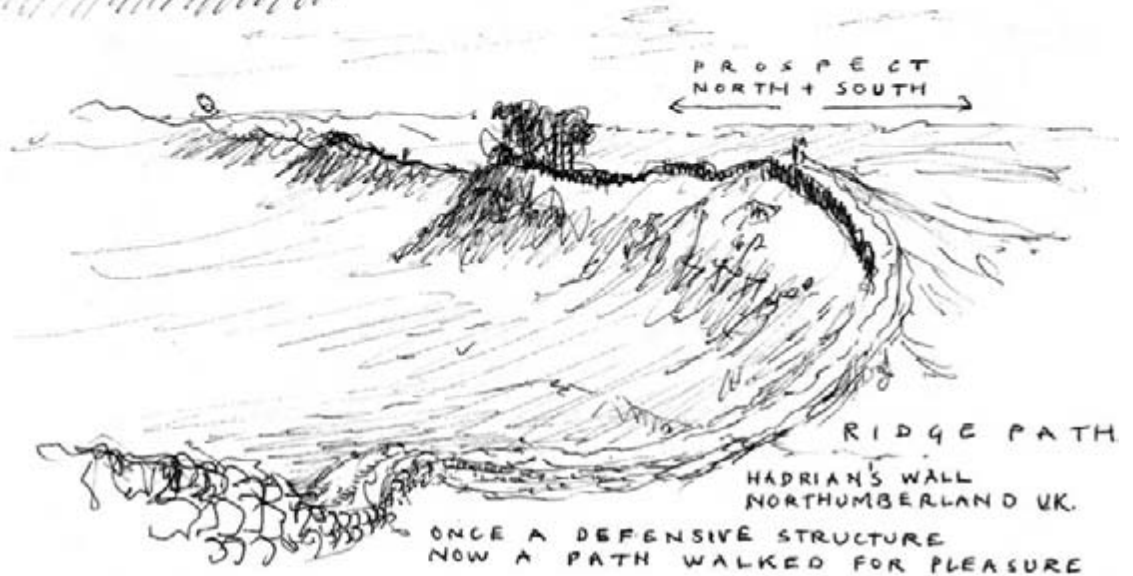


DYKE : RIDGE PATH OVER WET GROUND



Ridge paths

Ridge paths form routes raised on both sides above the surrounding topography. In their use, pleasure is derived from the prospect they allow in all directions and the feeling of exposure to wind, sky and sometimes water. Ridge paths can enclose and define space. Ridge path networks are developed on and are distinctive to wetland landscapes.
