

Architecture—landscape interface

The 'hybrid linear space' around buildings that is both landscape and architecture is an edge. The design of this physical interface can be thought of as the dual task of architect and landscape architect. Too often architect and landscape architect fail to work together creatively to

realise the design potential for this transitional space. For aesthetic and social reasons, strong physical connections between indoors and outdoors – where landscape penetrates buildings and interiors or facades project out into landscape – are often desirable.
