



Walls – buttressed and indented

Buttressed and indented walls provide sitting niches for social activity along their edge. They also provide niches for planting, sculpture or water. Wall structures of this form are inherently very stable and often give the appearance of great permanence regardless of age.

Permeable structures

Built structures such as open fences, railing or trellis forms are appropriate where visual permeability between one space and another is required without physical access. Many permeable structure designs are 'light' and integrating as they mesh together the landscape on either side (see also *Spaces/Built*, p. 73).
