

Inlets and harbours

Natural or artificial inlets from larger waterbodies are natural stopping and bridging points and are therefore places of threshold. On a large scale, harbours provide threshold spaces between sea and land.

Decks and platforms

Decks and platforms out over water provide people with intimate contact with water short of bathing or paddling. Decks allow people to fish, to occupy space among wildlife and water's edge vegetation, or be surrounded by the intense light that waterbodies reflect and the sound of water lapping against structure, beach or rock.
