

In Paris a walk starts at the beautiful symmetrically framed Place du Marché St. Catherine, off Rue Saint Antoine, turns right on Rue de Jarente, left on Rue Turenne, and right again to enter the Place des Vosges, where a statue of Louis XIII occupies the center of the square. The Paris walk appears to take longer than the walk in Venice.
