

The integrated design of places

In the following pages that complete this section, examples of integrated design are illustrated and explored with the aim of demonstrating how spaces, paths, edges, thresholds and foci form whole places and how design elements may be combined. Examples of integrated landscapes occur throughout the book, but this section aims to emphasise integration and to counteract the notion that the elements and forms in design as organised in the remaining parts of this book can be considered separately when designing.
