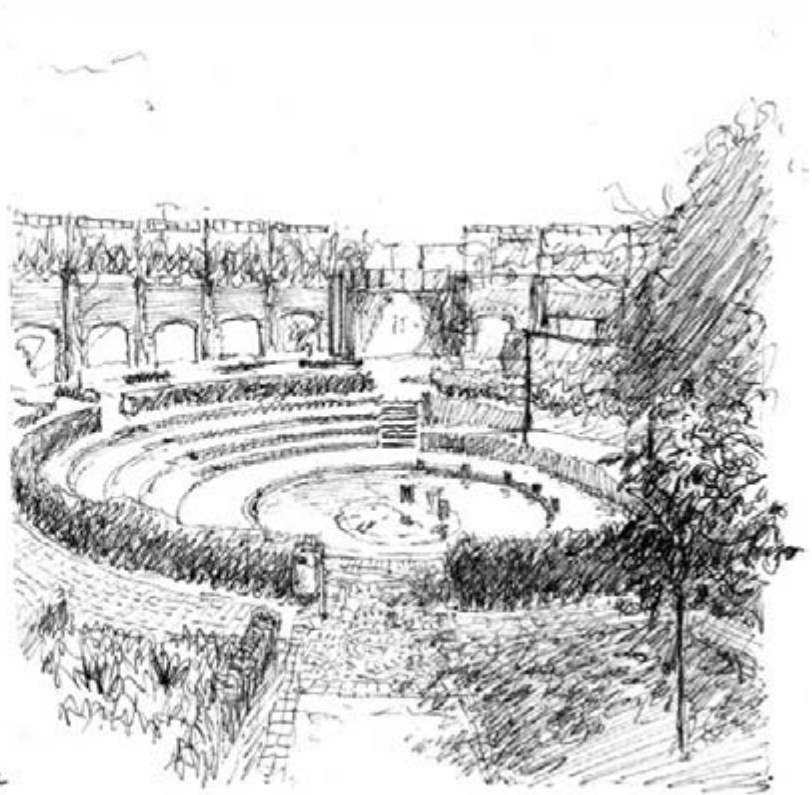
FORMAL VEGETATION ECHOES POOL
