

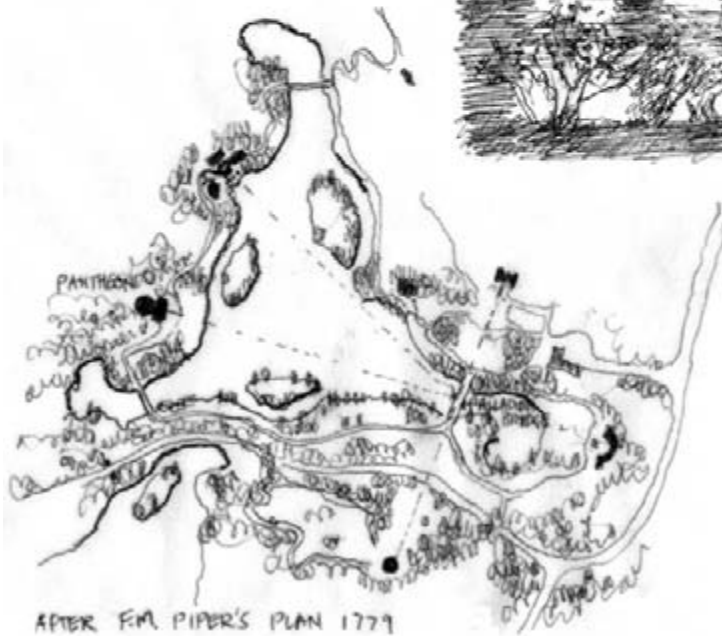
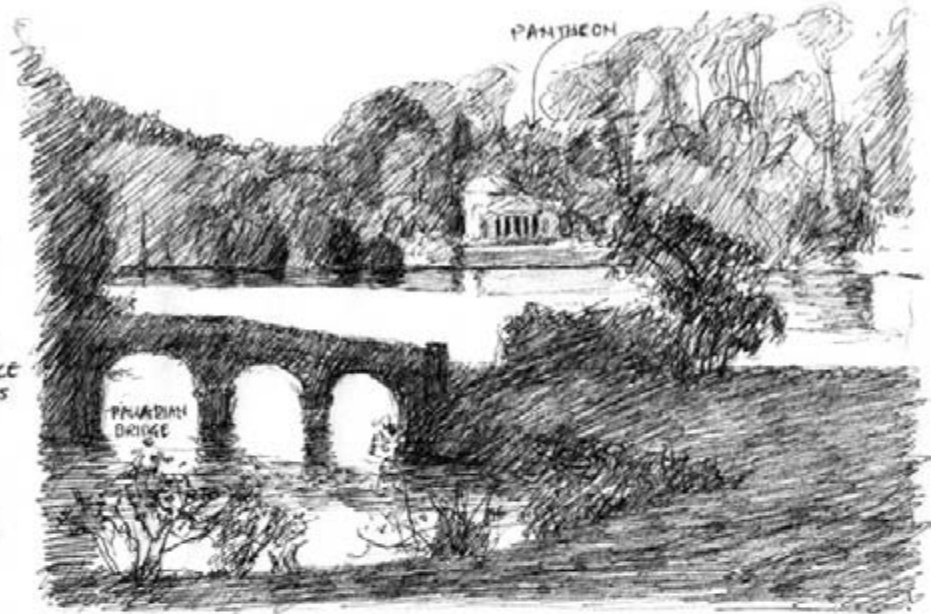

**TOPOGRAPHY + VEGETATION**

SMOOTH LAWN ACCENTUATES  
TOPOGRAPHIC SWEEPS WHICH  
ARE FRAMED AND ARTICULATED  
BY TREES.

**TOPOGRAPHY + WATER**

ROLLING TOPOGRAPHY COMPLEMENTS  
STILL MIRROR'D SURFACE  
OF WATER AND SINUOUS CURVES  
OF WATER'S EDGE.



**TOPOGRAPHY + STRUCTURES**

STRUCTURES SIT ON RAISED GROUND ALLOWING  
PROSPECT TO AND FROM THEM

**VEGETATION + WATER**

WATER REFLECTS MASS OF TREES AND  
CONTRASTS TO THEIR TEXTURE WITH A SMOOTH  
PLANE. WATER PROVIDES LIGHT. TREES  
DARKNESS. WATER CREATES SPACE TREES  
ENCLOSE.

**VEGETATION + STRUCTURES**

TREES CONTRAST IN TONE AND TEXTURE WITH  
STRUCTURES. VEGETATION IS CLEARED TO  
ALLOW VISTAS FROM ONE STRUCTURE TO  
ANOTHER.

**WATER + STRUCTURES**

STILL WATER REFLECTS STRUCTURES. WATER  
PROVIDES SMOOTH OPEN PLANE OVER WHICH  
STRUCTURES ARE VIEWED
