

2.8 Option testing


Presenting options is an important stage in project development. The range of alternatives must be presented consistently to ensure useful and reliable consultation and review. Plans, perspectives and diagrams at different scales can differentiate between the overall and the local, the general and specific. As well as illustrating what options could look like, other issues to consider illustrating include: the use of open space, traffic circulation, land uses, phasing of construction, and so on. An informal graphic style, with the options presented as simple diagrams to highlight points of difference will help focus attention on comparing elements and making choices.




Option 1: Minimal intervention
