



Scale of spaces

Scale refers to the perceived relative size of parts of the landscape to each other, to human size and to the emotional effect of this relative size. Hence, judgements can be made about scale. 'Too large or small in scale' can refer to relationships of parts of a landscape or to the size a person feels in relation to a landscape. Scale can also refer to size in relation to human activity, for example: 'this space is too small in scale for public events'.
