


Contrast and similarity of spaces

A landscape can be unified by repeating spaces of similar shape or size. Likewise, diversity in landscapes can be achieved through varying size or shape of spaces. The designer must make judgements about how much diversity and unity are required and may seek to balance the two to avoid monotony or chaos.
