

listed in the report. Such lists, resulting from brainstorming sessions with members of the public, are a useful starting point for an urban design study. Analysis of such long lists takes on greater significance if structured as shown in Figure 4.1 and arranged in some order of importance. The onset of the recession in the late 1980s made it difficult to achieve a property-based regeneration. It was particularly difficult to achieve a development control strategy which prevented the loss of clothing, textile and other manufacturing floorspace to offices.<sup>8</sup> The Lace Market Heritage
