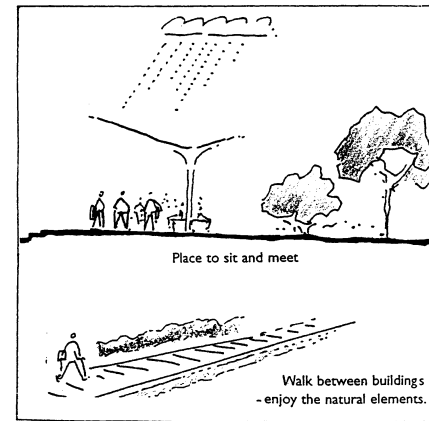

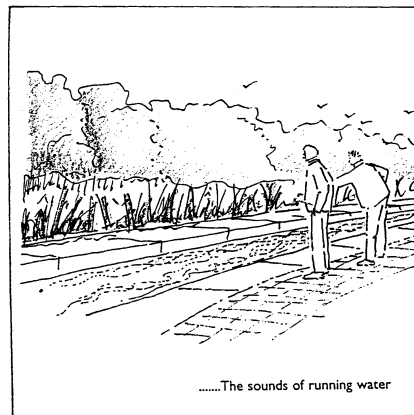

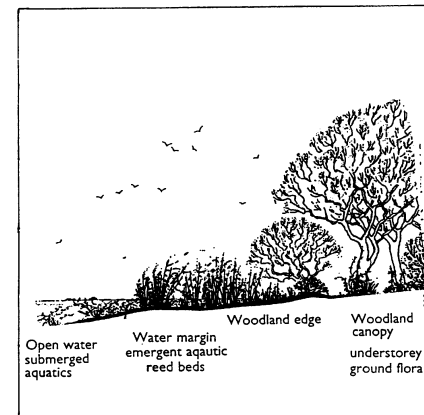
**Figures 4.20–4.24** The New Campus for the University of Nottingham, by Michael Hopkins and Partners: detail.
