IWAH Background:

IWAH stands from International Workshop on Asian Heritage. IWAH Workshop aims to seed the conservative awareness and exchange the experience. The workshop has 4 principles. There are

- 1. Goal: to create the opportunities to exchange the knowledge,
- 2. Participants: the collaboration among Asian,
- 3. Knowledge: to investigate and develop the local wisdom, and
- 4. Out put: the publication is one of progress that leads to other collaboration, moreover the local people could adapt and integrate the knowledge to develop their community.
 - IWAH 2015 was the first workshop that was hold in Thailand. The participants were the collaborations among Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi, Thailand, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, Johor Bahru, Malaysia, Universitos Godjah Mada, Yogyokarta, Indonesia, and Sebelas Maret University of Surakarta, Indonesia. The site was at Chinatown, Bangkok, Thailand. The objectives were to identify the essential elements of Asian street preservation and conservation, and to discuss and share the experiences of Asian urban conservation and street culture among participants.
 - IWAH 2016 was the collaboration between Kyoto Institute of Technology, Japan and Rajamangala University of Technology, Thailand. The site was focused on the Thai traditional vernacular that located in central Thailand at *Ayutthaya*. Vernacular Thai architecture is shown an evidence of harmony in traditional lifestyle and the water-based culture. It is one of the most valuable traditional Thai architectures, which is called "classical Thai house".
