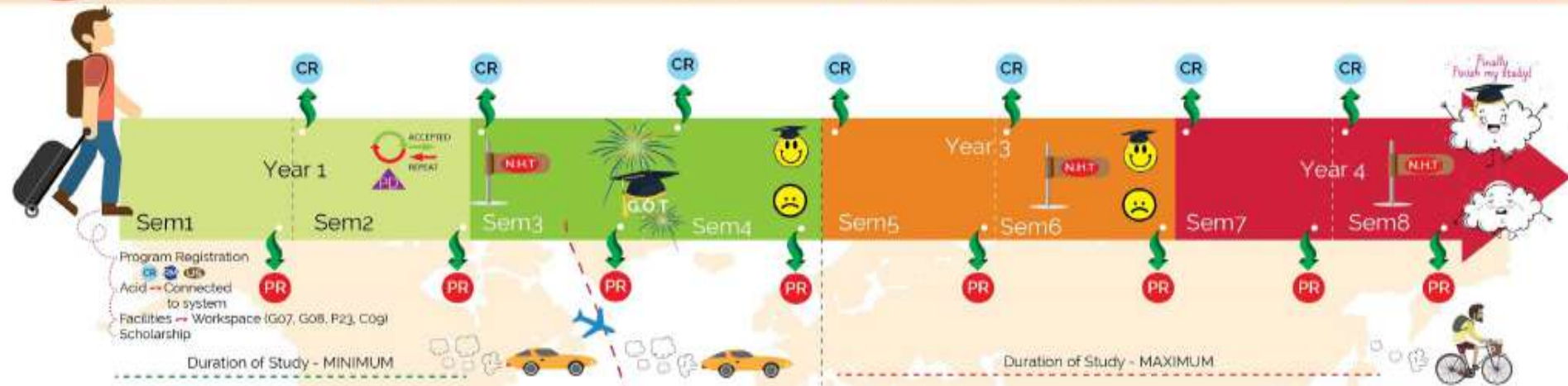

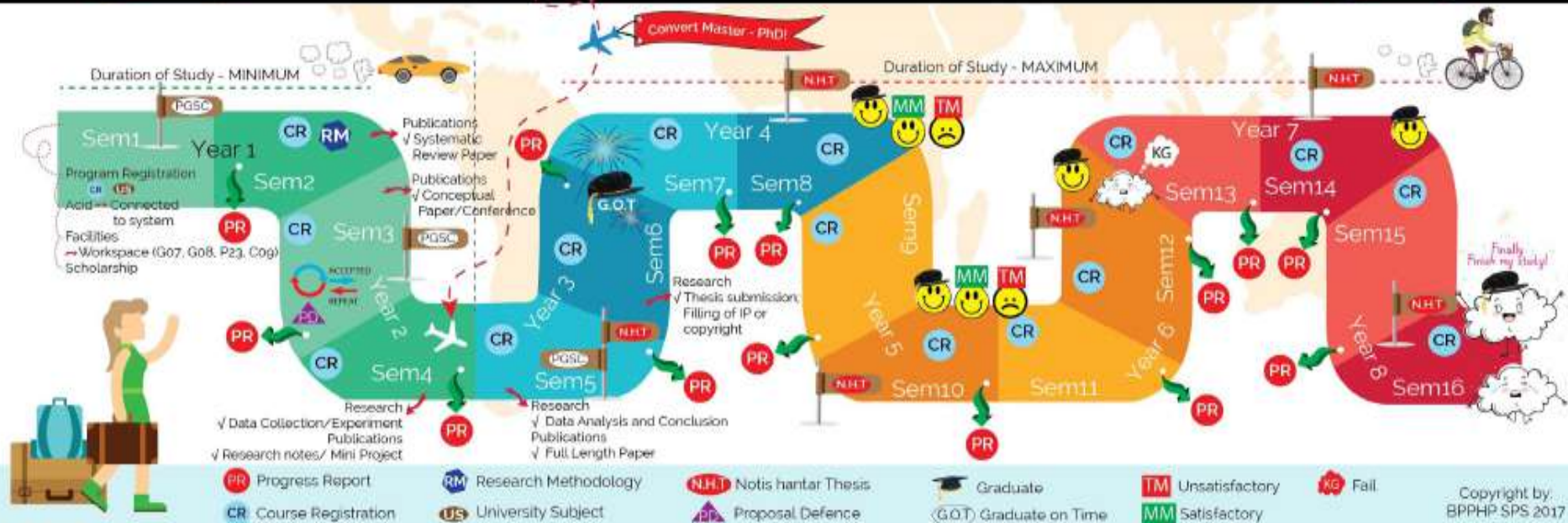

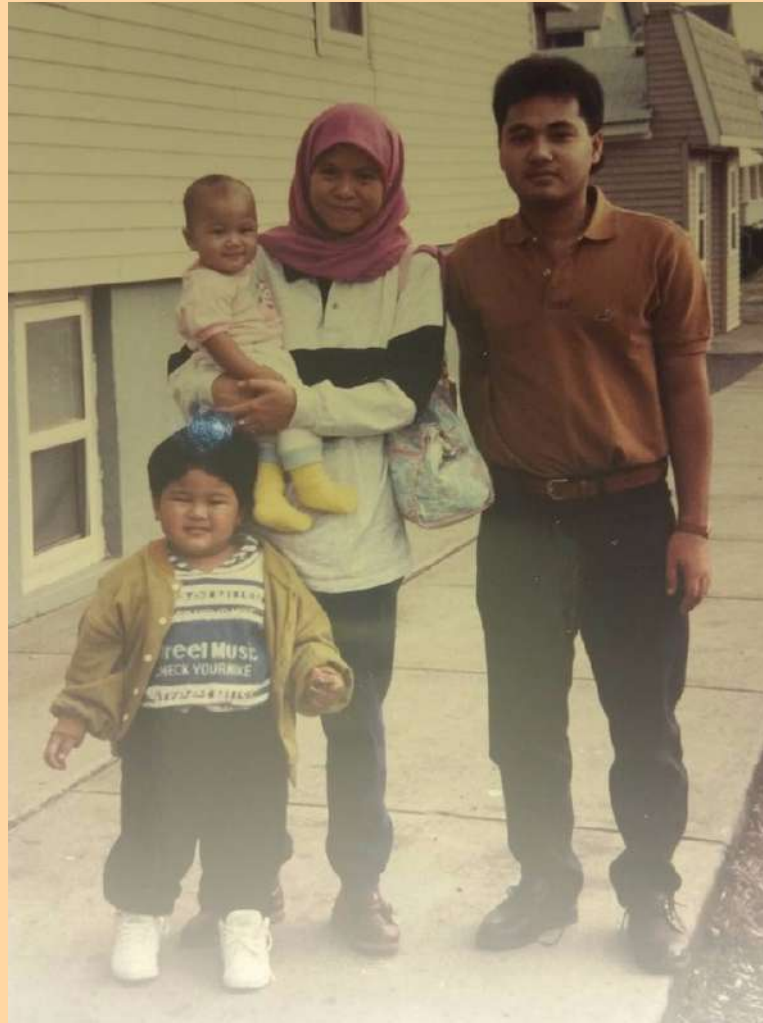

POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH JOURNEY

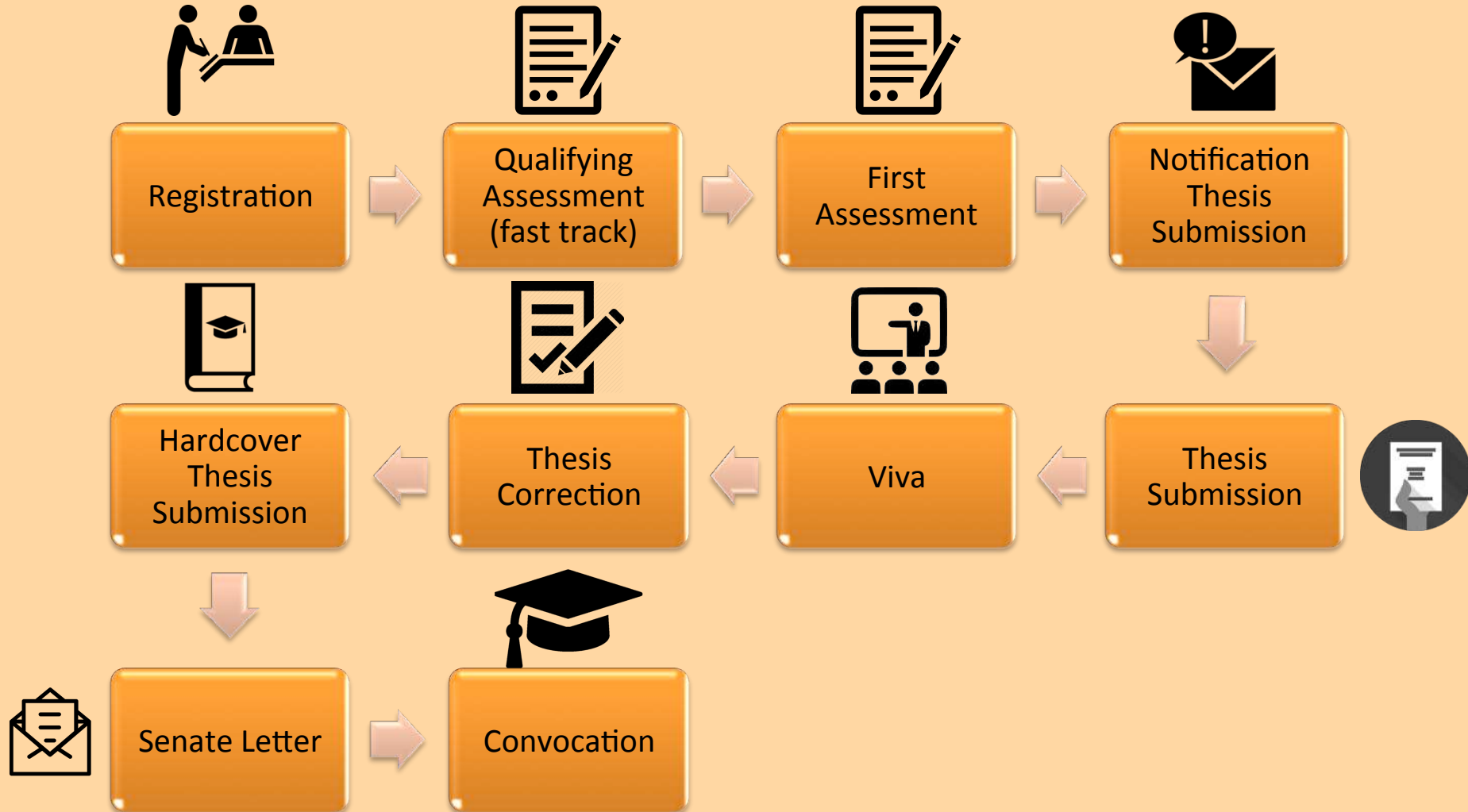

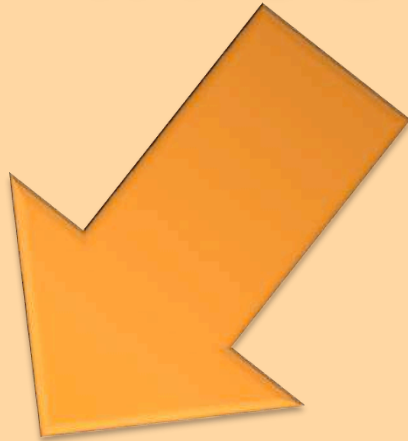

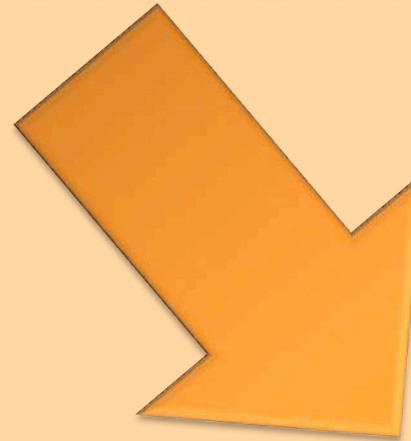
FACTORS CONTRIBUTE TO TIMELY COMPLETION (JIRANEK (2010))

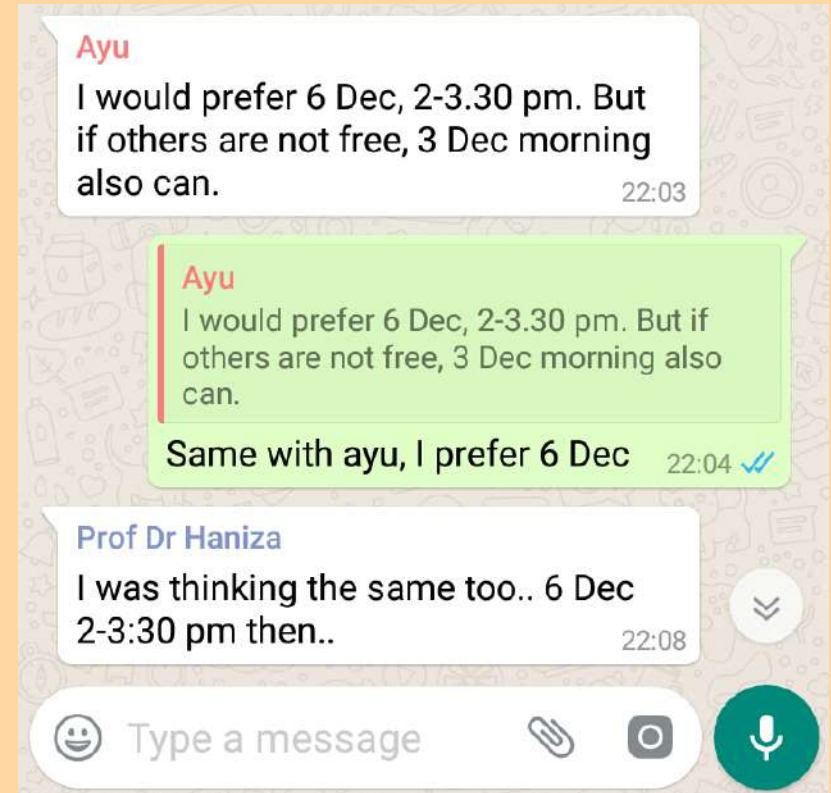

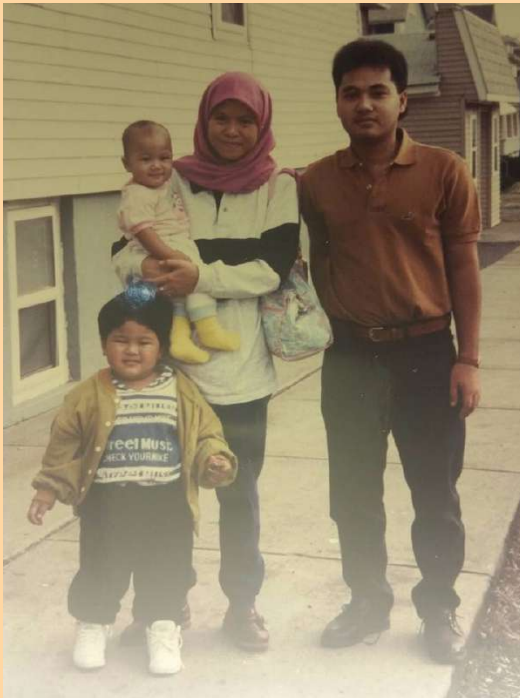
