Referencing of Survey Marks

In all Divisions where there is insufficient or no liaison other Departments likely to do work which may result in the destruction or displacement of boundary and traverses marks emplaced by this Department, Chief Surveyors are requested to set up liaising machinery so that marks likely to be affected can be referenced and easily replaced as necessary.

2. The form the liaising machinery should take is left to Chief Surveyors. The usual form would be for the Department concerned to inform the Chief Surveyor concerned of the locality and approximate time that Departmental proposes to carry put its work; the Chief Surveyor will then cause whatever marks are likely to be affected to be referenced. No doubt this referencing requires a certain amount of priority though replacement can be effected in leisure.
