

S.G. CIRCULAR NO. 3 OF 1960

In all cases where a mark is planted on a line, the mark must be proved to be really on line and recorded as such in the field book.

2. In cases where a new mark has to be planted on an old line indirectly, the new mark must be proved to be on that old line (by another traverse if necessary) and such proofs must be recorded in the field book. If the marks on either side of the new mark cannot be found, their positions must be refixed and re-marked.
